HOW AND WHERE DOES A PERSON REGISTER TO VOTE?

The Okeechobee County Supervisor of Elections is charged with the responsibilities of creating and maintaining the statewide voter's registration system. **In order for citizens to participate in the 2022 General City Election, they must be registered by October 11, 2022.**

WHERE DO CITY VOTERS GO TO CAST THEIR VOTE?



Military and Overseas Citizens and US residents may request a Vote-by-Mail Ballot; contact the Okeechobee County Supervisor of Elections, **DEADLINE** to request Ballot be mailed: **October 29, 2022.**



EARLY VOTING opens 15-days before an election, ends on the third day before an election, and allows voters to cast their vote on ballots in the same manner as of election day:

Oct 29 through Nov 5, 2022
